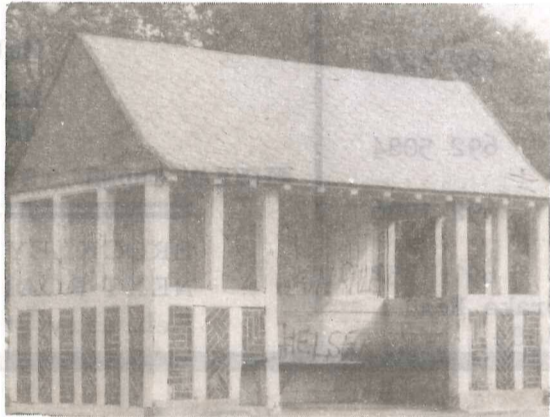

●●●● In reply to our Secretary's letter after the Annual General Meeting, to the Borough Engineer, we received a reply which included the following comments:--

" GRAFFITI - arrangements are being made for additional financial provision to remove several areas of graffiti. The railway bridge in Wickham Road is the responsibility of BR Board and I have written to British Railways."

" HILLY FIELDS SHELTER - I have arranged for this to be inspected so that consideration can be given to whatever maintenance appears necessary."



" CLEARANCE OF GRASS & WEEDS FROM FOOTWAYS

-- With the introduction of bonus schemes for road sweeping operations some years ago, the clearance of grass and weeds became a separate activity, and control is exercised by spraying during the growing season as and when necessary."

" BUILDER'S SAND AND CEMENT IN ROADS - My Staff take action where conditions appear hazardous by calling on the builders concerned. We are preparing a 'Code of Practice' on this subject for issue to builders."

The Society suggests that if you object to the unsightly grass and weeds in the pavement edge near your home, the only remedy is to remove them yourself. We have noticed that dog-fouling increases where the pavement is unweeded.

## Wednesday Club

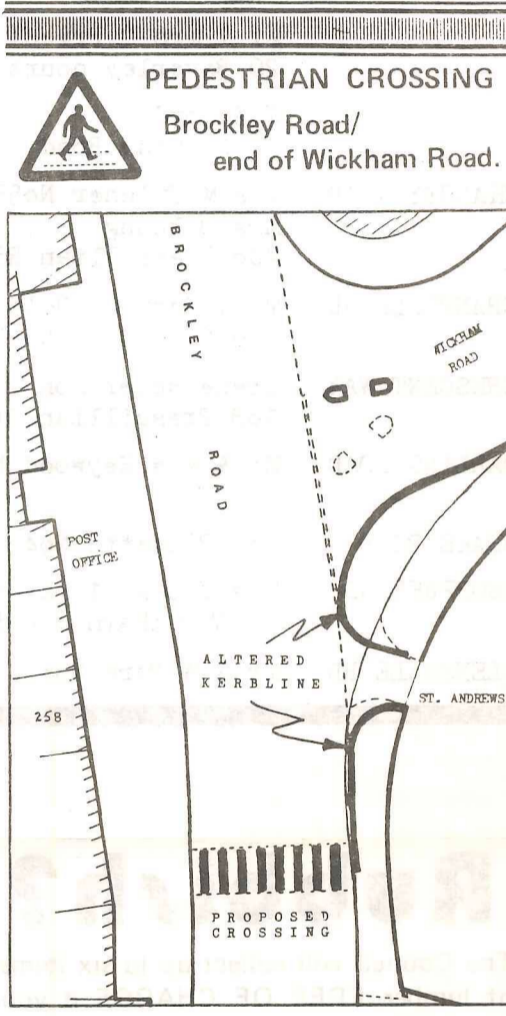

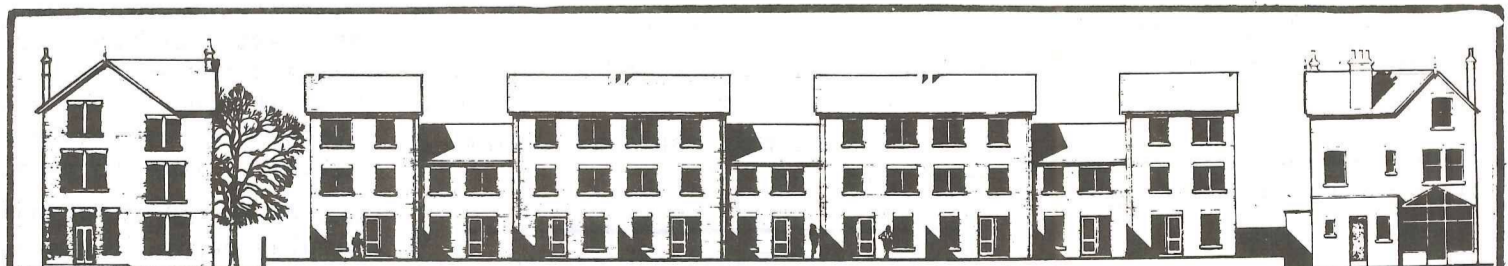
