Celebrating the 50th anniversary of Brockley Conservation Area

Brockley Society is a vibrant community association and charity, run entirely by volunteers, founded in 1974 to conserve the area's uniquely preserved Victorian architecture and to promote community activity. Associate membership is open to everyone, whether you live in the Conservation Area or anywhere else. You can become a Voting member if you sign up to our objects. We collaborate with other groups to strengthen and enhance our community and we always welcome new volunteers to help with existing projects or to bring new ideas!

To mark the 50th Anniversary of Brockley Conservation Area we are organising a conference **Conservation - Legacy and Innovation** in October 2023 at Lewisham College to look at what we can pass on to future generations. Houses destroyed in WWII bombing were replaced by council flats, but Brockley's unique enclave of Victorian houses continue to provide good accommodation for many people. Adapting and retrofitting them to meet the climate crisis must be done sensitively and appropriately for brick buildings and new building must be done to good design.



Our **Planning Group** (email *planning@brockleysociety.org.uk*) monitors planning applications in Brockley Conservation Area. We support innovative



and progressive design when appropriate | we offer help to residents to understand the local planning constraints | we oppose detrimental planning

applications | we have run conferences such as Innovation and Conservation | two one-day Festivals of Ideas for Change | a celebration of Brockley's Mews and Greenways | we founded Breakspears Mews Community Garden | incubated Street

Trees for Living (now a separate charity) | in 2015 we restaged the 1918 Mass Photo with thousands of local residents on Hilly Fields | we ran Brockley's Historic Mews Walk during the lockdowns and will run an updated version

on 16 September this year | the Hilly Fields Midsummer Fayre this year is our 48th | We are supporting the Reunion Family Day for Lewisham Way Youth & Community Centre on 29 July to celebrate its 40-year vital role | We run occasional historical walks | Open Meetings three times a year (19 July and 15 November) | Hilly Fields BBQ on 7 July | a Coordinated Front Garden Sale on 9-10 September | A printed newsletter three times a year | a circular email to 1800 people | Twitter and Instagram | Brockley Voices oral history project records residents' reminiscences | We have historical documents in our Archive | we own four listed Red Telephone Boxes (two are libraries, two with plans in progress).
